Be advised the Montgomery Board of Health intends to pass these regulations in 2025, at that time a permit will be required and the above fee will apply.	
** As of 11/10/2024 no Montgomery Board of Health regulations exist regarding the sale of tobacco. Any prospective tobacco retailer would be responsible to pay the above fee and obtain a tobacco permit as well as be in compliance with all State and Federal regulations. Be advised the Montgomery Board of Health intends to pass these regulations in 2025.
